An extra 15 minutes a day – the secret to Olympic success; a 1% change to sales and costs -- the secret to business success

That little bit of extra effort can make a huge difference, the FCA NSW/ACT State Conference and Franchising Excellence Awards heard in Sydney on Friday.

Presenting at the Conference and Awards was Olympian Brennon Dowrick, the first person to win a gymnastics gold medal for Australia in the Commonwealth Games (1990).

At the Australian Institute of Sport, Brennon trained for 7 hours a day, five days a week, for 18 years in order to excel among some of the world's most talented gymnasts, from Europe, the US and China.

But it was the extra 15 minutes a day he did when everyone else had left the gym which set him apart; and this was very analogous to business success, he told a conference of 130 delegates.

FCA Executive Director Steve Wright said that a 1% change to sales and a 1% change to costs can yield 15% or greater increase in profitability.

"The winners of the FCA Franchising Excellence Awards in NSW/ACT are obviously putting in the work to find that little bit extra – whether it be profitability, community contribution or helping others to achieve their goals," Mr Wright said.

The FCA Excellence in Franchising Awards celebrate the success of hard working small business people in the \$128 billion Australian franchise sector, both regionally and nationally.
